Artistry – Couture Oak Collection is made of European Oak. As a natural timber product, knots will be present, as well as the use of coloured fillers. Colour variation and grain are to be expected and will also vary on the floorboards. These variations will occur from batch to batch, between samples and the actual stock delivered and installed. These variations are normally present in the Artistry - Couture Oak Collection and are not considered defects. Furthermore, it will not form the basis of any claims under varranty.

The Prime (AB) grade is the finest timber grade, and the raw material is rare. This grade of timber is much more uniform in appearance and has a very smooth, straight grain in comparison to the Classic and Select timber grades.

Timber flooring is not colour-fast, and the colour will change over time when exposed to UV light. Surface checking may be present.
